Food and Nutrition: SNAP Enrollment

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly known as "food stamps", provides food assistance for low-income New Yorkers. SNAP enrollers at several sites help you with enrollment and referrals to partners for food pantries, soup kitchens, medically-tailored food delivered to your home, WIC, and congregate meals.
