What You Can Do To Fight COVID-19

Get vaccinated!

The COVID-19 vaccine is safe, free, and easy. It is the best way to protect you against the deadly virus. All New Yorkers 12 and older are eligible for the vaccine and walk-ins and appointments are available at various sites across the city. We highly encourage all NYC Care members to get their vaccine today!

Two weeks after you are fully vaccinated, you no longer need to wear a face covering or stay 6 feet away from others in many places. However, you should still take these prevention steps:

- + Stay home if you are sick
- + Wash your hands often
- + Wear a mask in indoor public spaces such as medical facilities and public transportation
